

‘Damascus Countdown’ Novel Depicts Iran Showdown

Author Joel Rosenberg has a knack for writing fiction that is chillingly close to reality, and he’s done it again in *Damascus Countdown*, the third and final installment of his Twelfth Imam series.

Rosenberg’s novels are entertaining, but he also has a track record of being quite prophetic in his fiction.

In *Damascus Countdown*, Israel has successfully launched a first strike on Iran, taking out all of their nuclear sites and six of their nuclear warheads. The result prompts the Twelfth Imam to order a full-scale retaliation.

The fictional U.S. President William Jackson threatens to support a U.N. Security Council resolution condemning the Jewish state for unprovoked and unwarranted acts of aggression.
