

Democrats Squabble Over Joe Biden's Poor Debate Performance

After last night's poor debate performance by Joe Biden, many were concerned for the well-being of the president. However, Kamala Harris and Gavin Newsom took to Biden's defense.

"What we saw tonight is the president making a very clear contrast with Donald Trump on all the issues that matter to the American people," Harris told CNN's Anderson Cooper.
