

Demonic Abortion Statue Beheaded During Hurricane Beryl

As Beryl stormed across Texas leaving millions without power, one particular point of destruction has some saying it was an act of God.

Taking up residence at the University of Houston following its reveal in New York City, the satanic, pro-abortion statue "Witness" was found beheaded in the aftermath of Beryl.

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Sikander's theory doesn't quite add up, and it is reasonable to assume if this was an act of vandalism which the UH had footage of, it would have been released by now. The university has said that "the damage is believed to be intentional," and "the University of Houston Police Department is currently investigating the matter."
