

Donald Trump: 'God Spared My Life for a Reason'

Donald Trump took the stage early Wednesday at Mar-a-Lago to celebrate his victory over Vice President Kamala Harris, securing his second non-consecutive term as president. Addressing an energized crowd, he declared, "This was a movement like nobody's ever seen before ... I believe, the greatest political movement of all time."
