

Donald Trump is Making a Big Move

Donald Trump is once again making headlines. This time it's because of a big move that he is making.

Fox News is reporting that Trump and his team are setting up their political headquarters in Mar-a-Lago and plan to "ramp up his travel schedule."

He and the former first family were formerly residing in his Bedminster golf club in New Jersey.
