

Exodus Evidence? Ancient Discovery Points to Moses' Pharaoh

A major archaeological discovery in Egypt is drawing fresh attention to one of the most debated figures in biblical history.

Archaeologists have uncovered part of a massive ancient statue in the eastern Nile Delta near the Red Sea, a region closely tied to the biblical Exodus narrative. The fragment, which includes the legs and base, stands about seven feet tall and weighs between five and six tons. It was found at Tel Faraoun during ongoing excavations led by Egypt's Supreme Council of Antiquities.
