The parents of Adam Raine, a teen who died by suicide back in April, discovered that it was his interactions with ChatGPT that led to his death.

As NBC News reported, Adam's father, Matt said they "...thought we were looking for Snapchat discussions or internet search history or some weird cult..."

However, as it turned out, ChatGPT held the answers to their questions. As it turned out, instead of talking to people, Adam began talking to the chatbot, not about his homework, but rather about suicide. Instead of preventing him from it or blocking and ending the chat, it only encouraged him toward it. Now, Raine's family is suing OpenAI for wrongful death.
