

Flames Engulfing the Carolinas, Is This a Wake-Up Call for America?

As the fires have grown, residents in close to half a dozen neighborhoods have had to leave their homes, while fires also erupted in North Carolina in the Blue Ridge region near the border to South Carolina.

Fox Carolina News writes that 30% of the fires in this area have been contained, and currently 481 acres continue to burn. Residents in the affected areas have been asked to evacuate.
