

Ghana President Declares Today a Day of Prayer, Fasting as Country Grapples With COVID-19

Ghana President Nana Akufo-Addo declared Wednesday to be a day of prayer and fasting as his nation deals with the coronavirus, news outlets report.

Ghana's Health Ministry states that there are 27 cases of the coronavirus in the country and that two people have died from the disease. The surviving 25 people are being treated in isolation.

Akufo-Addo implored both Christians and Muslims to pray for a swift end to the virus.

"Let us pray to God to protect our nation and save us from this pandemic," he said, according to IOL.

He posted a guide on Instagram to help Christians know how to pray, including a list of detailed prayer points.
