

'God Just Downloaded This Song Into Me': An Anthem for Conservative Thinkers

There is a new anthem for conservatives of the black community—it is their announcement of freedom which is part of a growing movement.

In August, *USA Today* announced that the number of black Americans supporting President Trump had jumped to 36 percent.

That number continues to rise as this past weekend conservative activist, Candace Owens launched what she termed "Blexit."
