

How America Is Paying Tribute to Charlie Kirk On a Day of Remembrance

As the world continues to mourn the loss of Charlie Kirk, America is taking time to recognize him for his significant contributions to society.

Tuesday, Oct. 14 is being called a “National Day of Remembrance” for Charlie Kirk Kirk on what would have been his 32nd birthday. Kirk was assassinated last month at Utah Valley University during the start of his fall campus tour.

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According to ABC News, President Trump is set to posthumously award Kirk with the Presidential Medal of Freedom as part of this day of celebration. Turning Point USA also posted 31 different ways to live as Charlie Kirk did in memory of him.

“In honor of Charlie Kirk’s 31 years on earth, here are 31 ways to live like him,” the first slide read.

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Some of the items included honoring the Sabbath, go to church, work out. read the bible daily, get married, have kids, be bold and courageous and pick up the microphone.
