At more than 1,360 feet below sea level, the **Dead Sea** is the lowest point of any land mass on Earth



Jerusalem's **Dome of the Rock** shelters not only a white rock marking where the Temple once stood, but also what Jews believe was the site of the Holy of Holies



The iconic **Western Wall** stands as the last remnant of Jerusalem's great Temple and is the most visited site in Israel



For centuries a hotspot for Christian pilgrimages, today **Nazareth** is the largest Arab city in Israel



The beautiful range of hills, valleys, forests, streams and fertile soil throughout **Galilee** make it a prime location for olive groves



Amid the spectacular ancient ruins of **Beit She'an** (renamed Scythopolis by the Romans) are such earthquake-surviving structures as this amphitheater



Until the late 1800s most believed the Church of the Holy Sepulchre was where Jesus' burial and resurrection occurred; today the **Garden Tomb** is widely seen as a potential alternative location

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
