

India Pastor's Relentless Pursuit of Jesus Sparks Miraculous Revival

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In a miraculous move of God happening right now in India, the faithfulness of one pastor and his utter reliance on God has sparked a church revival. Rev. Paul Thangiah followed the call of God and started a church in 1982.

"I kept focusing on building God's kingdom, spending time in prayer and fasting," Thangiah says.
