

Iran Uses AI to Mock Christ, Target Trump in Escalating Propaganda War

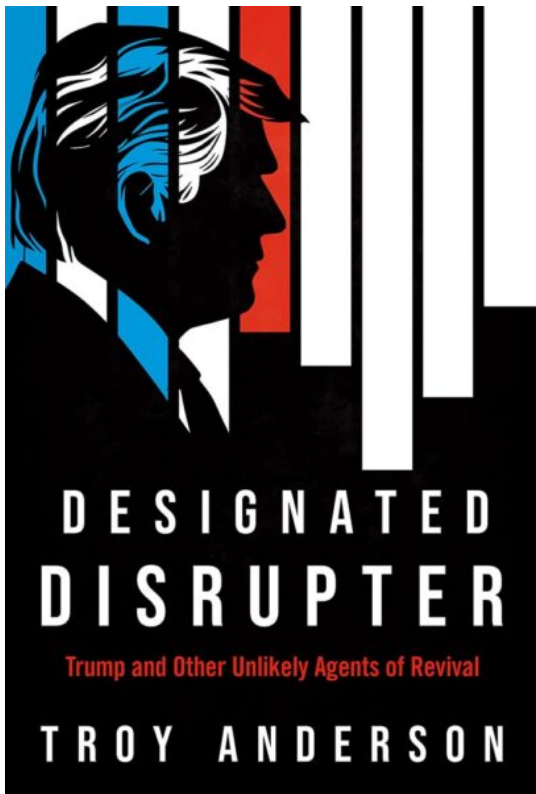
An Iranian-linked diplomatic account has circulated a shocking AI-generated video depicting Jesus Christ violently attacking [President Donald Trump](#) and casting him into hell, marking a new low in the growing digital war between the United States and the Iranian regime.

The video, which quickly spread across social media and drew millions of views, is part of what U.S. officials are calling a coordinated propaganda effort. Defense Secretary Pete Hegseth condemned the clip as “disgusting” and “detached from reality,” warning that it reflects a broader campaign to manipulate perception during the ongoing conflict.

The disturbing imagery did not emerge in a vacuum. Just days earlier, Trump faced backlash for posting AI-generated images portraying himself in Christ-like settings, images that many Christians criticized as blasphemous. Iran’s response appears to weaponize that controversy, flipping the imagery into a direct attack not only on the president but on the sacred image of Jesus Christ Himself.
