At the same time, artificial uterus technology is rapidly advancing, and other pathways may be opening to allow for the development of fetuses outside of the body.

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Not only are we talking about the creation of these “bodyoids,” but using artificial wombs just takes everything to an entirely next level.

Believers should be discerning about what lies beneath the surface of these so-called breakthroughs. What was once unthinkable is now spoken of with casual detachment, reducing life itself to mere components for experimentation. While the promise of medical advancement sounds noble on the surface, Christians must ask: at what cost? When humanity is treated as a commodity and creation is reengineered in the image of man rather than God, we risk crossing dangerous lines that defy divine order and purpose.
