

Kanye West to Host Easter 'Sunday Service' at Coachella

Grammy-winning rapper Kanye West has announced he will be bringing a distinct gospel twist to this year's Coachella music festival. Announcing his "Sunday Service" show on a recent flight, he took the opportunity to reveal that the gig would coincide with Easter Sunday—something that will likely excite his churchgoing fan base.

West's music has, at times, contained a deep spiritual meaning.
