

Man Drowns Trying to 'Get to God' on Camping's Judgment Day

He couldn't swim.

But that didn't stop Victor Frasnó from trying to cross a reservoir to 'get to God' moments before the first earthquakes of 'Judgement Day' were supposed to strike.

The 25-year-old from Florida, who had been staying with family in California, eventually drowned in the 80-acre reservoir in Contra Loma Regional Park, Antioch on Friday night, investigators said.

Frasnó, who was described by investigators as very religious, had also tried to pull his older brother into the water after saying he had been 'chosen'.

The 27-year-old, who has not been identified, managed to wriggle free before scrambling up the bank to get help.

He last saw Frasnó thrashing about while quoting from the Bible.

Authorities pulled Frasnó's body out of the lake just before midnight on Friday. Judgement Day was pegged for the next day based on a prediction by Oakland-based evangelist Harold Camping and his Family Radio group.
