

‘Man Shall Not Live on Netflix Alone’: Nick Hall Releases ‘The Bible Quarantine’

Nick Hall, founder of the Millennial-led evangelism movement Pulse and visionary behind the 2020 national Year of the Bible campaign, is launching a new daily Instagram TV series to help people stay spiritually healthy during the coronavirus outbreak.

“The Bible Quarantine” explores subjects that are currently dominating the national discussion in America, such as the meaning of church when people physically cannot meet together for worship and how to deal with fear in the face of the uncertain. Each episode is seven to eight minutes long and is posted at 9 p.m. ET. The series’ first episode, “Closed on Sunday,” received an initial 11,400 views across platforms.
