

Mandisa's Celebration of Life Ceremony to be Livestreamed

Christian artist Mandisa Hundley will have her life and legacy celebrated this weekend after her death on Thursday, April 18.

As The Tennessean reported, Hundley, more affectionately known as Mandisa by fans, will be celebrated in two different services. The first service will be held at Fisk University, Mandisa's alma mater on Friday April 25.

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Fisk University's Jubilee Singers are also planning to dedicate a song to Mandisa during their commencement ceremony on May 5.

The second service to celebrate Mandisa's life will happen tomorrow, April 27, at Brentwood Baptist Church in Brentwood, Tenn. The visitation will take place from 9-10:30 a.m. before the service begins at 11 a.m. You can livestream the service at

The passing of the 47-year-old singer was a shock to fans and those close to her. A former contestant of the hit TV show, "American Idol," Mandisa made an impact on those both on and off the stage.

"Her joy was infectious & I loved her heart to encourage people on & off stage!" Christian singer Danny Gokey wrote on Facebook. "Mandisa you left too soon—our community will never be the same without you."

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Christian artist Natalie Grant also shared her sentiment on Facebook about the loss of Mandisa as a dear friend and talented singers.

“I remember making our Opry debut together. We were so excited. But I remember our conversation so vividly. You belonged there. You always belonged, Disa,” Grant wrote.

Currently, the Franklin, Tennessee police department is continuing to look into the case of Mandisa’s passing.

“At this time, there is no indication the death was the result of suspicious or criminal activity,” the department wrote on X.

During this sensitive time, let us continue to pray for the comfort and peace of the family and friends closest to Mandisa, as well as all of the lives who were inspired by her music.
