

Mike Huckabee Calls Millions to Intercession During 'A Day to Pray' Event

This summer, former Arkansas Gov. Mike Huckabee promoted "Chick-fil-A Appreciation Day," which broke sales records for the chicken chain. Now, he is drumming up support for a prayer initiative next month.

Huckabee is encouraging millions of Americans of all political affiliations to unite in prayer on Jan. 20, for an event called "A Day to Pray." He's asking for prayers for our country, President Barack Obama, Congress and governmental leaders across the nation.

"Join me for 'A Day to Pray,'" the Facebook event page says, "where we will ask God to grant our leaders, from the local school houses to the White House, the wisdom they need for the road ahead. This will not be a political rally but a spiritual event and hopefully one that can help bring us together as we move forward as a nation."

Huckabee's letter, posted on the Generals International website, starts with the verse 2 Chronicles 7:14, "If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land."
