Isaiah Saldivar: The Surprise Awaiting Some Christians on Judgment Day

Revivalist Isaiah Saldivar has a message for many people in the church who call themselves Christians about their journey to heaven: You're not going to make it.

Speaking at a conference last weekend at Pastor Greg Locke's Global Vision Bible Church in Mt. Juliet, Tennessee, a fired-up Saldivar says some people are only pretending to be believers, but have no relationship with Jesus. And, he says, the consequences will be dire.

"I'm going to tell you why some of you are struggling," Saldivar says. "It's because you have no secret history with God. ... I know I'm going to make tons of people mad when I say this—the heresy hunters are fresh out of content—so put this in a religious pipe and smoke it.
