JERUSALEM, ISRAEL – It didn't even take a week.

In the first few days after Hamas began their barbaric and genocidal attacks on Israel, the American and international media mostly did a good job reporting on the atrocities committed by Hamas.

### **Did Hamas Ever Want Peace with Israel?**

In the midst of the horrors of the last week, it's important to remember that Hamas has never wanted peace with Israel. Instead, the express goal of Hamas since its inception was the destruction of Israel.

As stated in its first charter, published in 1988, "Israel will exist and will continue to exist until Islam will obliterate it, just as it obliterated others before it." It was—and is—the mission of Hamas to obliterate Israel, not make peace with Israel.
