Brazilian Assemblies of God Pastor, Wife Die Attempting to Save Son From Drowning

Brazilian Assemblies of God Pastor Felisberto Sampaio and his wife, Inalda, tragically died while trying to save their 13-year-old son from drowning during a vacation trip to the beach this past week, media outlets have reported.

Reports say that Sampaio, 43, and his wife, 42, saw their teenage son struggling in the water at Camcari Beach in Brazil on Jan. 10. Both parents entered the ocean in an attempt to rescue their boy, but they failed to reach him.

Civil Police reports say a fisherman and one of his family members pulled Ian Sampaio out of the water safely, but both parents failed to emerge from the ocean. Reports say the local fire department confirmed to "Universo Online" that the victims were eventually removed from the water and that paramedics attempted to revive them, but soon after declared

the couple dead at the scene.
