The story behind Mica Miller's recent death is a tragic one, and resulted in a life lost far too soon.

Amid the wave of theories, speculations and accusations levelled against her husband, Pastor John-Paul Miller of Solid Rock at Market Common in Myrtle Beach, South Carolina, Miller's behavior can be described as erratic at best.

While the couple was in the process of separating, Mica Miller had filed for three "separate support and maintenance" requests within the last year. John-Paul still delivered a eulogy during a May 5 memorial service.
