Pence To Trump: I'm 'Never Gonna Stop Praying for You'

In the days after Jan. 6 emotions were flaring as the country looked on in confusion and horror.

Researcher Reveals Stunning Data on Power of Prayer, Faith

A researcher who studies young people has found something stunning: those who pray and have a connection with God are more likely to flourish regarding happiness and mental health.

Dr. Josh Packard, executive director of Springtide Research Institute, told CBN's Faithwire about his extensive research into 13-to-25-year-olds, noting studies have long found "religion is good for you."

"Faith and spirituality are good for you," Packard said. "If you're a person who believes in some kind of higher power and has a connection to that higher power, you're generally flourishing more than your peers." {eo}

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
