Top Christian Voices Call Nation Together in Prayer for Damar Hamlin

All eyes were on the Buffalo Bills, Cincinnati Bengals game Monday night after Bills safety Damar Hamlin collapsed on the field. Fans and viewers around the world were shocked when he suffered a cardiac arrest during the game. Now, people are unifying across the nation in prayer for Hamlin and his family.

"He was transferred to the UC Medical Center for further testing and treatment. He is currently sedated and listed in critical condition," The Bills posted on Twitter. The collapse happened after Bengals quarterback Joe Burrow threw a pass to Tee Higgins and Hamlin rushed over to tackle.

Following the heartbreaking incident he was taken in an ambulance to the hospital. The NFL released a statement saying their "thoughts and prayers are with Damar, his family and the Buffalo Bills." The NFL also announcing they are postponing the game.
