

NASA Confirms Mystery Fireball Seen Across Multiple States

A sudden blaze across the sky left thousands asking the same question: What just happened?

On April 7, a massive fireball streaked across the Mid-Atlantic in broad daylight, triggering alarm and confusion.

A Shocking Sight Across Multiple States

According to CBS New York via MSN, eyewitnesses across Pennsylvania, Delaware and New Jersey reported seeing a bright object tear through the sky.

As The New York Post noted, many described a brilliant flash followed by glowing fragments—some appearing green—scattering midair. Others reported loud booms, with some saying the sound was strong enough to shake homes.



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The New York Post reported that nearly 200 sightings were submitted to the American Meteor Society, highlighting how widespread the event was.

NASA later confirmed the object was a meteor fireball.
