

Pastor John Gray Still Hospitalized, But One Blood Clot in Body Has Disappeared

Spirit-filled pastor John Gray, senior pastor of Relentless Church in Greenville, South Carolina, remains hospitalized, but his wife, Averter, posted on social media that one of the blood clots in his body is gone.

On Tuesday, Gray, who has been hospitalized since late last week for **a life-threatening saddle pulmonary embolism**, which Charisma News reported earlier this week, was transferred to a hospital in Atlanta, where Averter Gray said her husband will receive “the best care to figure out the rest of this saddle.”

Averter Gray gave an update on her husband’s condition on Instagram Tuesday:

“Thank you, God, still holding. If it is not faith, I don’t want it! Life! That is all. God is not done! No premature death. Leg clot gone (take that, devil). Remaining lung clots dissipate & bow at the name of Jesus! All will stay in place because they have to obey the voice of the Lord! Then, they will be obliterated.

“I am ready for the rest of this miracle! We had a small, God-ordained divine delay, but God is good. Trusting God again as we transfer to a hospital in Atlanta.”

Averter Gray says she and her family appreciate continued prayers from the body of Christ.

“Thank you for your prayers and outpouring of love,” she said on Instagram. “Please continue.” {eoa}
