

Pastor's Daughter Shot After Church Service, Suspect Previously Removed From Congregation

A 19-year-old woman, identified as the daughter of a local pastor, was shot outside her home after returning from a church service in east Houston, in what authorities describe as a violent confrontation involving individuals connected to the same congregation. Her identity had not been released at the time of reporting.

The incident unfolded around 9:37 p.m. on April 14 in the 2100 block of Hartwick Road.

According to a report from KPRC 2, the suspect, 24-year-old Emanuel Marin, "allegedly confronted her outside her house after she returned home from a church service."
