

Pro-Life Prayer Vigil, Demonstration Set for Planned Parenthood Abortion Center in Nation's Capital

A planned prayer vigil will take place on Thursday, Jan. 20, from 9:00-11:00 a.m. at 1225 4th Street NE in Washington, D.C., at the Planned Parenthood Abortion Center on the eve of the March for Life.

The event is being organized by Purple Sash Revolution and Priests for Life.

As Roe v. Wade is torn down, pro-life organizations will continue to focus their attention with greater intensity on defunding and replacing Planned Parenthood, the largest abortion provider in the world.

Brandi Swindell, founder and CEO of Stanton Healthcare, states:
