

Pronoun Wars in the White House? Trump's New Policy that is Shaking the Media!

And the only people making issues in America about pronouns are people that are hijacked by demonic spirits,” Locke says.

By taking decisive action against the use of preferred pronouns in the White House press room, the administration is drawing a bold line in the sand, emphasizing biological truth over cultural trends. For many believers, this issue transcends policy and taps into a deeper spiritual battle over truth, identity and God’s original design for humanity.
