

Prophetic or Political? Trump's President's Day Message

President Donald Trump is sending both a powerful and prophetic message this President's Day.

On X, the White House shared a President's Day message featuring a Time magazine cover of Donald Trump labeled "Trump's World," with stories on "The Gaza Deal," "The Fight for Taiwan," and "Putin's Power Play."

Underneath, this, however, was Trump's prophetic quotation: "I was the hunted, and now I'm the hunter."
