

Prophetic Revelation: Rainbows Following Queen Elizabeth II Passing

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As crowds gathered around Buckingham Palace after the passing of Queen Elizabeth II a remarkable “sign” shone throughout the sky. Thousands were in awe as a double rainbow arched over the castle right next to the flag at half mast.

The longest reigning monarch died at 96-years-old, leaving the country and those around the world mourning the loss of the defender of the faith. She was vocal about her faith especially in her final Christmas address on Dec. 25, 2021 saying Jesus was the “bedrock” of her faith.

For the mountains may be removed, and the hills may shake, but My kindness shall not depart from you, nor shall My covenant of peace be removed, says the LORD who has mercy on you.”

God is clearly speaking to His people through the passing of the queen. Many are feeling uncertain especially as King Charles has been quoted that he will be the defender of faiths (plural) as the head of the Church of England.
