

‘Psychology Today’ Reverses Gay Therapy Stance

The magazine and website *Psychology Today* has reversed its position and will not allow therapists to place ads offering to help people grappling with same-sex attraction, according to news reports.

The Human Rights Campaign, a gay rights group, first pressed *Psychology Today* to drop the ads in February.

Charles Frank, who runs the organization’s Directory of Therapists, originally told *The Huffington Post* that while the magazine was not a “fan” of so-called conversion therapy that “the Therapy Directory cannot pick winners.”
