

RFK Jr. Says 'God Sent Me Donald Trump' in Answer to Prayer

"What is happening to our children?" Kennedy asks. "And I saw this happening. I began writing about it and the media rose up and silenced me, in 2005, and nobody would talk about it,"

Kennedy recalls. “The doctors wouldn’t talk about it, the pediatricians wouldn’t talk about it, the scientists, the government officials. And people warned me, if you keep talking about this, you’re going to destroy your career.”
