

Russian Strike Destroys Christian Aid Warehouse, but It Cannot Stop the Gospel

A Russian strike destroyed a humanitarian warehouse operated by Ukraine for Christ, wiping out years of supplies used to serve displaced families, grieving households, soldiers and communities near the front lines.

The Aug. 28 attack destroyed the ministry's office, food, equipment, tools, generators and vehicles, according to Christian Daily International. Global Aid Network Canada also reported that 29 elderly residents died when the strike hit a neighboring care home.

"Now everything has been destroyed: food, boxes, equipment, tools, generators, vehicles," Ukraine for Christ said in a Facebook statement.
