Though still young in her ministry, Krick undeniably is a rising voice in the modern-day move of God. As she travels, preaching and praying for the sick, the miraculous continues to follow. While she did not always feel equipped to do so, like Moses, God is using Krick in ways that speak of the Holy Spirit's incredible power.

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"Public speaking was my biggest fear and weakness," Krick says. "But in this moment God reminded me of Moses... he was like, 'Lord, how can I do this? I have a stutter.' But God said, 'I made your mouth; I will give you the words to speak, just believe, just obey.' So, I knew God was speaking that to me right there."

Krick's journey serves as a powerful reminder that God's plans far exceed our own. Her faith and obedience to His calling should inspire us to seek Him wholeheartedly, trusting that He equips those He calls.

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
