

Tony Blair, Gaza and the Board of Peace: A New Step Toward End-Times Prophecy?

As Gaza remains at the center of global attention, a development quietly unfolding behind the scenes is capturing the world's attention.

Former British Prime Minister Tony Blair is reportedly taking on a larger role within the Board of Peace.

That warning appears to be at work right now as international leaders continue pursuing increasingly complex peace frameworks in Israel and Gaza.

Now, with Blair's influence growing and the Board seeking new ways to implement its vision despite mounting obstacles, this is the time to pay attention. Peace in the Middle East is being pursued, and we are edging closer to the very end of time. In the middle of it all, we are called to not be fearful, but to live expectant.

Whether we want to believe it or not, Bible prophecy is unfolding right in front of us at this very moment.

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
