

Trump Addresses Republican National Convention, 'by the Grace of Almighty God'

Donald Trump officially accepted his party's nomination as he addressed the country during the fourth and final night of the Republican National Convention on Thursday evening.

He took center stage to speak as the Republican Party's 2024 presidential nominee.
