

Trump Suggests Pre-Midterm Convention

President Donald Trump took to Truth Social on Thursday to suggest a national convention for Republicans prior to the 2026 midterms.

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Democrats have also considered holding a convention leading up to the midterms. According to a report from Axios, Democratic National Committee Chair Ken Martin has floated the idea to leaders in Minneapolis. The report explained that people familiar with the matter said the convention is intended to
