

Were Giants Real? New Evidence Links Biblical Nephilim to North America

While early 20th-century newspapers and even Smithsonian records mention discoveries of massive skeletons, the artifacts have seemingly disappeared. Some believe scientific institutions actively suppressed these findings, either due to evolutionary biases or the implications they could have on the accepted history of human origins.

Native American traditions also tell of red-haired giants, man-eating creatures and warfare against towering beings—stories that strangely align with biblical accounts of violent, corrupted giants who defied God's order. Could it be that these cultures were describing the same beings from Genesis 6?
