

World Leaders Respond to Donald Trump's Election Triumph

Leaders from around the globe are reaching out to congratulate Donald Trump on his election victory after he defeated Kamala Harris with 277 electoral votes to her 224 votes, with several states still counting votes.

Israel's Prime Minister, Benjamin Netanyahu provided his well wishes to Trump through a post on X.
