"I told the demons, 'Do what you want,' and I gave them entry into my life," Tony Maisey testifies. The partnership with darkness began very early in his life. His grandmother performed backstreet abortions during World War II, allowing a spirit of murder to enter his blood line. His parents dabbled in the occult and witchcraft in the home when he was a child, which brought a stronghold of fear in his life. He would not walk by himself into certain areas of the home because it triggered intense dread.
