

Amanda Grace Rebukes Piers Morgan Over Witch Doctor Interview: 'This Is Highly Dangerous'

Prophetic voice Amanda Grace is sounding the alarm after broadcaster Piers Morgan recently featured a Ghanaian witch doctor on his program, warning that what many may dismiss as harmless entertainment carries serious spiritual implications.

In a recent video message, Grace expressed deep concern over Morgan's decision to platform someone part of the occult, arguing that doing so can open what she described as "legal doors" in the spiritual realm.

"So, on June 26th, Piers Morgan had a witch doctor from Ghana on his broadcast," Grace said. "Piers, what the h***—and I mean that—are you thinking?"

Grace contended that the issue extends far beyond a controversial interview. She explained that promoting occult practices exposes people to spiritual forces they are unequipped to confront apart from the authority of Jesus Christ.

"These are demonic forces that Piers Morgan has no clue how to deal with, nor is he equipped to deal with," she said. "He is basically giving them a carte blanche entry point into his life."

Throughout her message, Grace repeatedly emphasized that Scripture provides the only true authority over the powers of

darkness. Citing James 4:7, she reminded believers, "Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you."

Grace noted that involvement with the occult creates what she described as "legal doors" that allow destructive spiritual influences to gain greater access in a person's life. She likened those openings to "a highway and a portal in the realm of the spirit," warning that such activity should never be viewed as harmless curiosity or entertainment.

"He may think it's harmless," Grace said of Morgan. "He's going to find out this year what he just did is not so harmless. He's going to have some things start to happen in his life that he's not going to be able to explain."

She added that the only answer to such spiritual attacks is the name of Jesus Christ.

"You know who he's going to need to call on? The name of Jesus Christ," Grace said. "That's who Piers Morgan is going to need to call on because of what he is opening up in his life."

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Grace also warned that occult practices involve what the Bible describes as principalities, powers and familiar spirits. She claimed these spiritual entities seek to exploit weaknesses and gain influence over individuals who knowingly or unknowingly give them access.

"This is not innocent stuff," she said. "This is highly dangerous."

Her comments come as public fascination with the supernatural, paranormal and occult continues to grow across entertainment, social media and mainstream culture. While opinions differ sharply on these subjects, Grace urged Christians to exercise biblical discernment and avoid any involvement with practices

Scripture associates with divination or the occult.

Rather than responding with fear, Grace encouraged believers to pray.

“So learn from this,” she concluded. “Don’t go near it, and pray for Piers Morgan right now, with what he may endure from opening such a door.”
