

Amanda Grace Weighs In on Pope Francis: Is This an End Times Warning?

Is the timing of Pope Francis' death the sign of something on the way?

Recently, prophetic voice Amanda Grace chimed in with how she believes the timing of Francis' death during the end of Passover has greater implications in the spiritual realm than we could imagine.
