

Amanda Grace's Disturbing Dream: Pray Now For Turning Point USA

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Prophetic voice Amanda Grace is urging believers to pray with renewed urgency after sharing a troubling dream that she believes points to a potentially significant period surrounding the one-year anniversary of Charlie Kirk's death.

Speaking in a recent prophetic update, Grace said she waited several days before discussing the dream, spending time in prayer before making it public.

"I have to talk to you about this dream that I had," Grace said. "I've been sitting on it for a few days and praying."

According to Grace, the dream occurred on July 10, 2026—exactly two months before what she identified as the first anniversary of Kirk's death. In the dream, she saw flyers that appeared to advertise a church event, but the words "Turning Point USA" were printed across them.

"The flyers looked a little dark and dim," Grace said. "The atmosphere around looked a little dark and dim."

Grace emphasized that what follows is her interpretation of the dream, not a confirmed event. She said she believes it could be a warning of an attempted attack connected to a Turning Point USA event or headquarters around the anniversary of Kirk's death.

"I believe what we may be looking at is... one of the largest attempted attacks on a Turning Point USA event or headquarters in order to make a statement," she said.

Because of that impression, Grace urged leaders associated with the organization to seek God's wisdom in the weeks ahead.

"The leadership must seek the Lord now for wisdom rather than making a grand statement in this hour," she said.

Grace also drew attention to what she views as significant timing. She noted that Charlie Kirk died on Sept. 10, and the subsequent manhunt extended into Sept. 11, and this year's Rosh Hashanah, also known as the Feast of Trumpets, begins on Sept. 11.

She then pointed to Proverbs 9:10, saying the verse carries particular significance because of the date.

"The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom, and the knowledge of the Holy One is understanding and spiritual insight," Grace quoted.

She encouraged viewers to see the passage as a call to pursue discernment rather than fear, saying wisdom and prayer are essential in confronting what she believes could be a developing threat.

Grace concluded by urging Christians to intercede that any harmful plans would be exposed before they could be carried out.

"This needs to be exposed," she said. "Pray and intercede... so it doesn't accomplish what it's truly looking to accomplish."

This is the time to remain spiritually alert, seek God's wisdom and respond to uncertainty with prayer rather than panic. She closed by encouraging believers to stay immersed in Scripture, listen for the Holy Spirit's direction and remain steadfast in faith as September approaches.
