

Los Angeles Awakening: Thousands Turn Out as Revival Momentum Surges

God isn't done with the city of Los Angeles. He's just starting something powerful.

At the 2026 Hope Fest LA, thousands gathered to hear the gospel, engage in dynamic worship and hear from powerful speakers, including Pastor Ché Ahn, who is running for California governor.
