

# Tucker Carlson and Alex Jones: Who Is the Antichrist?

In a culture increasingly consumed by technology, global control and moral confusion, a surprising new conversation is taking place, not among pastors or theologians, but between Tucker Carlson and Alex Jones regarding the rise of the Antichrist.

"All I know is we should be having a discussion about the Antichrist," Jones said. "I think you need to know the enemy."



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Carlson then described his understanding of the evil that would be noticeable regarding the Antichrist candidate.

"From my of of those books in the New Testament is that the Antichrist reserves the powers of God for himself. He pretends to be God. You know, 'I'm all powerful...' those are signs of evil," Carlson said.

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As technology and global influence expand, the conversation about the Antichrist serves as a stark reminder that spiritual realities are not distant or abstract. In a world where power and pride often masquerade as divinity, believers are called to vigilance, prayer and awareness, knowing that the spiritual realm is as real as the world around them.
