

William Branham's 1954 Prophecy: Was the Rise of an American Pope Inevitable?

For the first time in history, a man from the United States has ascended to the papacy—an event prophesied to be the beginning of a global religious shift more than 70 years ago.

Cardinal Robert Francis Prevost of Chicago, now Pope Leo XIV, was elected by the Vatican conclave despite concerns over American geopolitical influence. Born in Illinois and ordained in 1982, Leo XIV holds dual citizenship with Peru and has spent decades in missionary work across South America.

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
