

A Joyful Reminder of What Awaits Believers

“In the seventh month on the first of the month you shall have a rest, a reminder by blowing of trumpets, a holy convocation” (Lev. 23:24).

What was the blowing of the trumpets reminding the children of Israel of? They were to solemnly remember and commemorate the day when they were gathered at the base of Mount Sinai, and the Holy God of Israel, Yahweh Himself, appeared on top of the mountain in glory.

The Jewish people have continued throughout their history to set aside this time as a reminder of this incredible day when God manifested His presence. The very fact that this has been passed on from generation to generation, speaks to the reality that God manifesting His glory to all of Israel, 3,500 years ago, really happened. It is a historical reality.

Now, Let's consider how this all relates to the fulfillment of the return of Yeshua.

“For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel and with the trumpet of God, and the dead in Christ will rise first.” (1 Thess. 4:16).

I want to impress upon our hearts today that Messiah's return, which will be announced by the blowing of a trumpet from heaven, is an actuality that will be experienced by all. You can put your entire faith in this truth. Just like the Jews today continue to mark this sacred holiday, we also need to celebrate that His eminent return is a certainty.

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“Yes, I am coming quickly” (Rev. 22:20).

Why would these be Yeshua’s last words recorded in the Bible? Because, He wants us to live with our eyes focused on His return and each day live in the light of eternity. Jesus is truly coming back for us. We must consciously live in the knowledge that He is going to reward each of us according to what we have done (Rev. 22:12).

Beloved, one day soon: no more sorrow, no more pain, no more sickness, and no more heartache. Imagine this, a time filled with eternal happiness, joy, and lacking nothing—we have all this and more waiting for us.

“I heard a loud voice from the throne, saying, ‘Behold, the tabernacle of God is among the people, and He will dwell among them, and they shall be His people, and God Himself will be among them, He will wipe away every tear from their eyes; and there will no longer be any death; there will no longer be any mourning, or crying, or pain; the first things have passed away’” (Rev. 21:3-4).
